

Trimble Robotic Total Station



Using our Trimble Robotic Total Station (RTS) as a live link between design documents and the construction site has been a great success to being more efficient and accurate with layout and accelerating construction activities.

Our crews are able to view the 2D drawing or 3D building model on a tablet. They use survey points from on-site to locate the RTS which then gives the operator the ability to view the model in reference to its position. Using precise dimensions, the RTS uses a laser and allows us to mark points on-site with incredible accuracy.

Decker Electric is one of the few electrical contractors to utilize this equipment within the state.
